Happy New Year – and Happy Three Kings to everyone.

The Christmas season brought a welcome respite from things-Rotary. With the new year comes the last six months of my term – and for reporting to Rotary International, we have about four months left to complete all our projects.

Our Christmas Party was a great success – and thanks again to IP Gerard and all the members who managed to help us on the day. Our next large club activity will be the Club Anniversary, on the 18th of February. VP Flo has already begun to conceptualize the affair and once again we will need your support to make it memorable.

In between, we have the 3rd Leg of the Governor's Golf Cup at Luisita on January 12, followed by the District 3790 Mid-Year Review, which will be held in Laoag this year on January 14 (overnight trip – we leave on the morning of the 14th and come back the next day). On February 10-12 the District will be holding the RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Awards) and Family Day at the Fontana Resort on Clark Air Base.

For those wanting to plan even further (!) ahead, we will have our annual Golf Tournament at Camp John Hay on March 10. The PESETS for Bishop Cinense's term as District Governor will be March 18 at Subic. The District Conference for 2005-06 will be in Dagupan, from April 21-23. So now you have all the upcoming events to mark in your calendars and hopefully, you can join some of the events I have mentioned above.

The Board has been reasonably frugal in dispensing funds in the first semester of the Rotary year – now we that we know how much money we have, we can begin to implement a number of projects that have been on hold. Further, IP Gerard is working on a Matching Grant to give in to Rotary International, so that the Grant can be implemented in his term as President. We hope to be able to get approval to work on the water system of Luding as our major project. RC Cannes is looking at being our supporting club in this endeavor.

We have guidance counseling for high schools coming up, more books for our Poyopoy Elementary School library and the Luding Day Care Center, a partial road access to build in Luding, several more medical missions, de-worming of the kids in Poyopoy and Luding, projects with our Interact Club of Phases, we may renew our micro-finance scheme with the Luding farmers, form a sisterhood agreement with several clubs who have been supporting our projects, Vocational Awards to hand out and a number of other things on our agenda to accomplish. We are also still looking for some more members to join the Club, which will enable us to have more helping hands to succeed at what we are now doing.

For our members who were quite busy in the first semester and didn't have too much time to get involved, I hope the year 2006 finds you with a little more time to devote to Club activities. It is all about volunteering, to help others in need of our support. Our Board of Directors have much to do, and time will now seem to pass more quickly as we start winding down this Rotary year.

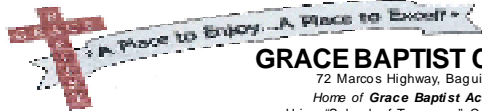
