## PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Greetings from your president. I hope you still remember what I look like – this will be the third meeting in a row that I am absent!

I am off to Alilem, Ilocos Sur for our third outreach mission – the Alilem mission is becoming a yearly affair in terms of community service for our Club – Luzon Hydro Corporation through Dir. Chris Faelnar is once again sponsoring us to reach out to a community that doesn't get much attention in terms of medical, dental and surgical services. As of today, we have 13 Rotarians joining us – not bad for an overnight mission.

IP Gerard is off to France (he left Friday), so we had a meeting with the incoming Board to determine what are the goals and objectives for RY 2006-2007 on Tuesday night. IP Gerard discussed the various possible projects and activities and now the new Directors will begin the process of planning what will actually be the Club's goals and objectives in the coming Rotary year.

The Matching Grant application for a water distribution system in Luding has been completed. Director Bert and IP Gerard should be congratulated. We will now have to wait and see if Rotary International agrees with the project – if approved, we are looking at a project that will cost about US \$13,500.

Director John Santos has completed our Vocational Awards, which were given to outstanding employees of Baguio City Hall. Although it took a while, the process of choosing the exemplary employees was a stringent one – as required by the president (!).

Director Bert's next project is a composting seminar with the Department of Science and Technology in Luding. This seminar should give the farmers better methods to maximize their crop rotation and hopefully a better harvest as well.

Incoming Director John Santos is busy with our Scholarship Program, preparing for next year's scholars and taking care of the ones we have at present. We are trying to document everything about our RCB scholarship program, so that we can also begin to find new sources of income to be sure our program continues. We want to look after our RCB scholars even better, ensuring a measure of success by being able to focus on their schooling and become positive influences in our community when they enter the "working world" so to speak.

As we enter the month of April, the process of documentation and turnover begins, so that the next set of Officers and Directors begin their year with their eyes open, knowing fully what is expected of them. It is also a time to begin reflection – on what we have accomplished this year – and passing on how things could be done better in the succeeding term. Perhaps it is also a time for each member to consider what part they have played in the Club this year – not just at the weekly meetings but in the Club activities, fellowships and other things we have done through the course of this year.

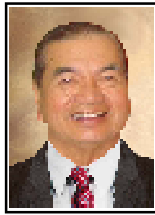

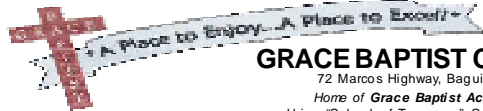
