

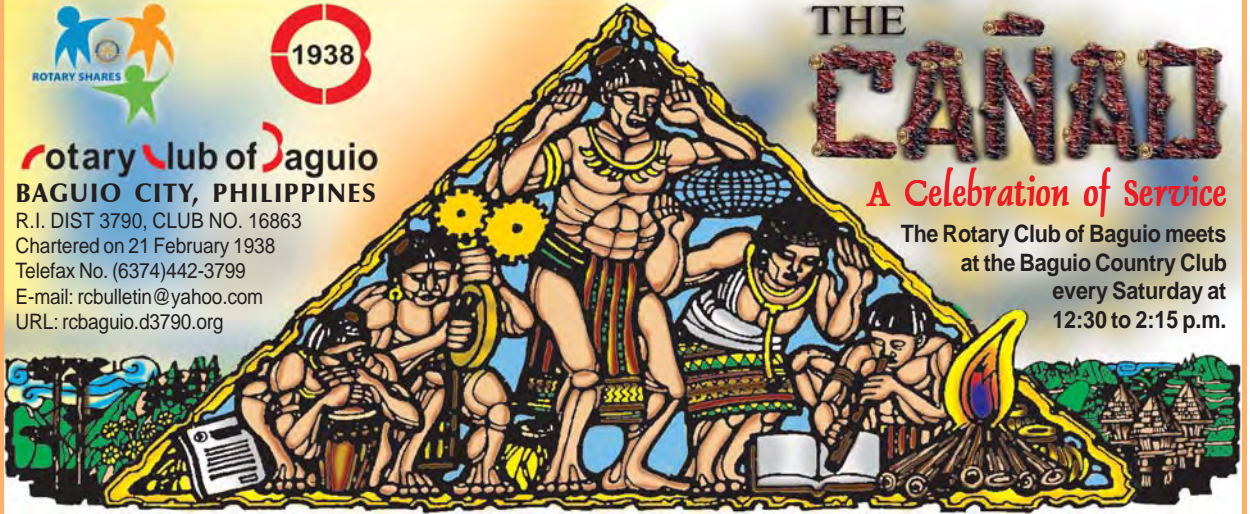

VP Ben Ladilad gave justice to the Guest of Honor and Speaker, Dr. Romeo A. Gomez, by not missing any of the important credentials and accomplishments attached to his name. Young at that, we have learned that Dr. Gomez had already accomplished a lot and is worthy to speak on the topic: Ecological Waste Management.

The Honorable Guest Speaker started his talk by defining Wastes and Waste Management. He enumerated the elements of the sustainability of waste management and stressed on the fact that everybody contributes to different wastes and waste management should therefore be a shared responsibility. Waste management, according to the honorable speaker, has both a legal basis (RA 9003 of 2001) and an ecological basis. RA 9003 requires all LGU's to have a Sanitary Backfill for waste disposal over Incineration after considering the 3 R's of waste management, namely, Reduction, Recycling and Re-use. With this provision of the law governing waste management, it will really be burdensome in the part of the Local Government Units. Will it be affordable and practical to them? The law of Ecology is constant motion. The best approach to Ecological Waste Management is that it should be holistic and with political and cultural acceptability. It should be an Integrated Waste Management.

Interesting questions, addendum, comments and responses were entertained during the Open Forum. VP Ben Ladilad gave a brief talk with regard to the topic thus making the issue more interesting. PP Helmut on the other hand discussed on how things are being done in Germany where in Incineration is an accepted way of disposing off waste. Rtn. Ping Paraan's concern was the effectiveness of the waste management of Baguio and for PP Mike, his concern was the involvement of the citizenry on the pressing problem of waste management.

Rtn. Gigi Maranan started her Response by informing the membership that the father of the Guest of Honor and Speaker was also once a speaker in the Club. To show the club's gratitude, a plaque of appreciation was awarded to the honorable speaker by no other than Pres. Raffy Chan.

The singing of "Pilipinas Kong Mahal" echoed in the hall before Pres. Raffy banged the gavel at exactly 2:50 PM to signify the end of another lively and fruitful afternoon of Rotary!

THE CAÑO A Celebration of Service

Our Official Club Bulletin has been called The Caño. “Caño” (*pronounced as kan-yau*) is actually the local term for the dance during native feasts or celebrations in the highlands of the Cordilleras- in Northern Luzon of the Philippines.

This is depicted in our Caño emblem (above) which shows a number of human figures in deep concentration—absorbed in ritual dance.

The attention, focus, commitment and unity of the club’s members is represented by the dancing figures—in celebration or expectation of a bountiful harvest; much as we actually do—in anticipation of the joy derived from public service to the community—always coupled with fellowship. Hence, the sub-title of “A Celebration of Service.”

The Rotary Club of Baguio (RCB) was chartered on 21 February 1938. The 4,587th member of Rotary International and the oldest club organized North of Manila; the 6th chartered Rotary Club in the entire Philippines.

Our over-simplified club logo (red) is a composite of the letters r, c & B; this is symbolic of the club’s straightforwardness. Over-all cardioid-heart shape connotes that our members serve from the heart. The four basic elements (four quadrants—now 3D bevelled) are symbolic of Rotary’s Four-Way Test and the members’ commitment to it. Our charter year of 1938 is used as the mid-focal point of the logo, to emphasize our early beginnings and continuing dedication to *Service Above Self*.
