

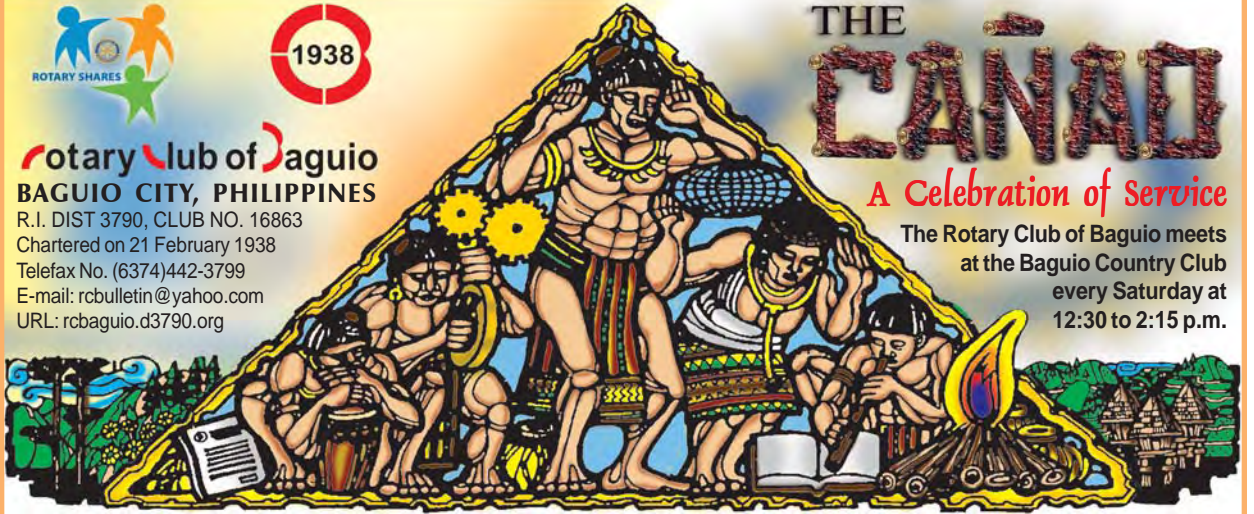

Your president is ecstatic to report that we have garnered a total of nineteen recognitions in the recently held District 3790 Year End Review which was held at the Oxford Hotel at the Clark Freeport Zone in Pampanga. Of these, thirteen (a lucky number for me!) were awards for the RCB and seven were individual recognitions for members of our club. My meal-raffle stub for that day was number 13 (lucky, indeed); so Someone was already telling me that something great was about to happen! To reconcile on the matter, refer to my President's Corner from last week and look at my third article—where I refer to Divine Providence....

Our top recognition garnered for the evening would have to be the **Outstanding Club of the Year Award**. Right after that are the ten District Recognition Awards—as Top Club in Attendance (this is very notable—I think), Rotary Community Service, Vocational Service, International Service, Human Development, and others. President Wilfrid “Wilf” Wilkinson; and publicly bestowed on IPP Gerard during our Sapphire Jubilee Celebration last February at the BCC Ballroom.

## IN RETROSPECT



### The Meeting That Was 07 June 08

We did not sing the Rotary Hymn because there was no tape but our ever-charming and intrepid Editor in Chief Dhory Vicencio obliged us with the Entertainment. If you don't know where you're going in life, then maybe it's part of the plan to take a step back and take a look at your life. What were you born to do? What are you happiest doing? When you have that answered, you can use that to decide what you want to do in life. Angels give us the answers to everything. Also, trust them when they suggest an answer.

In summary: Remember who you are. Your guardian angel is there to help you.

And have fun. If you are not enjoying your life, it's your fault...
